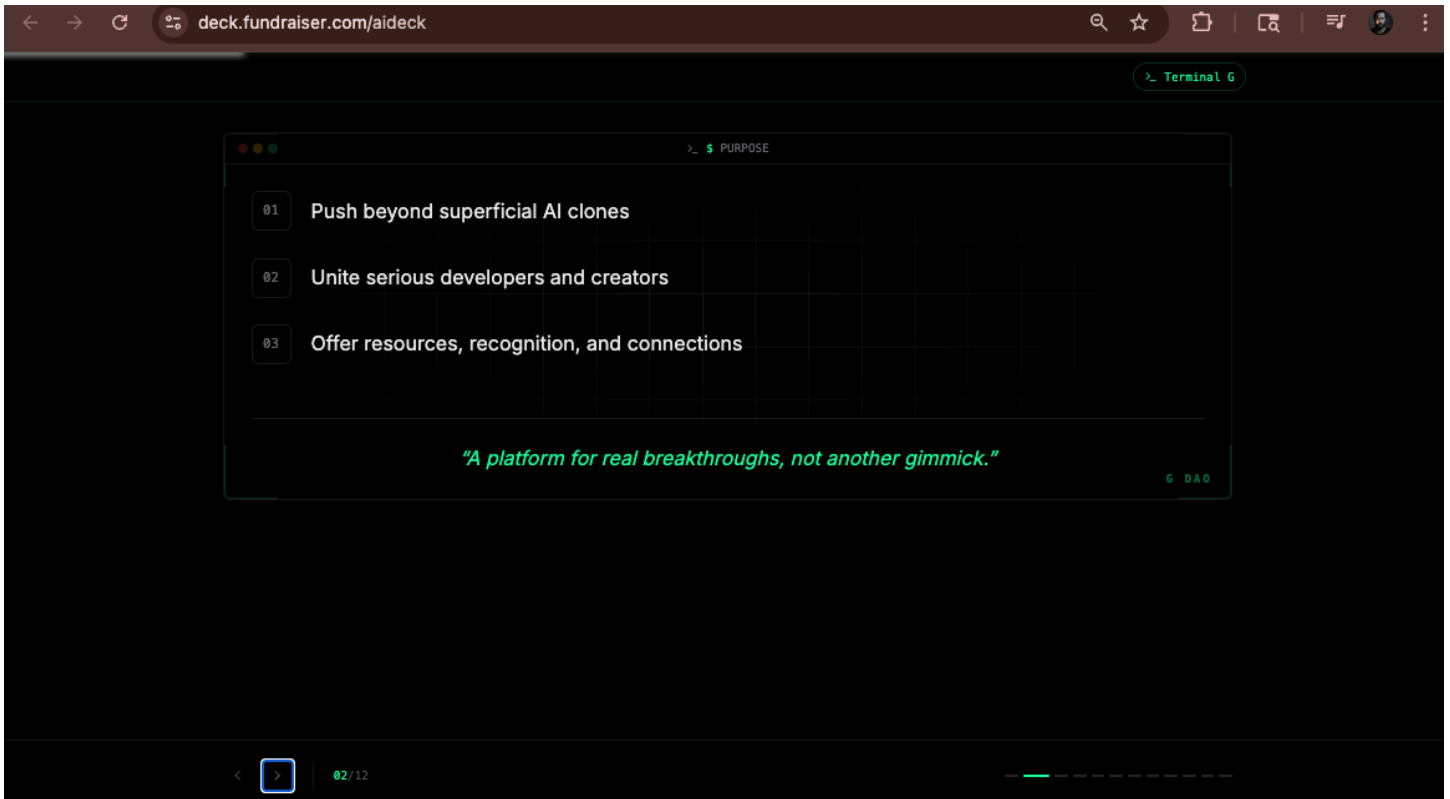

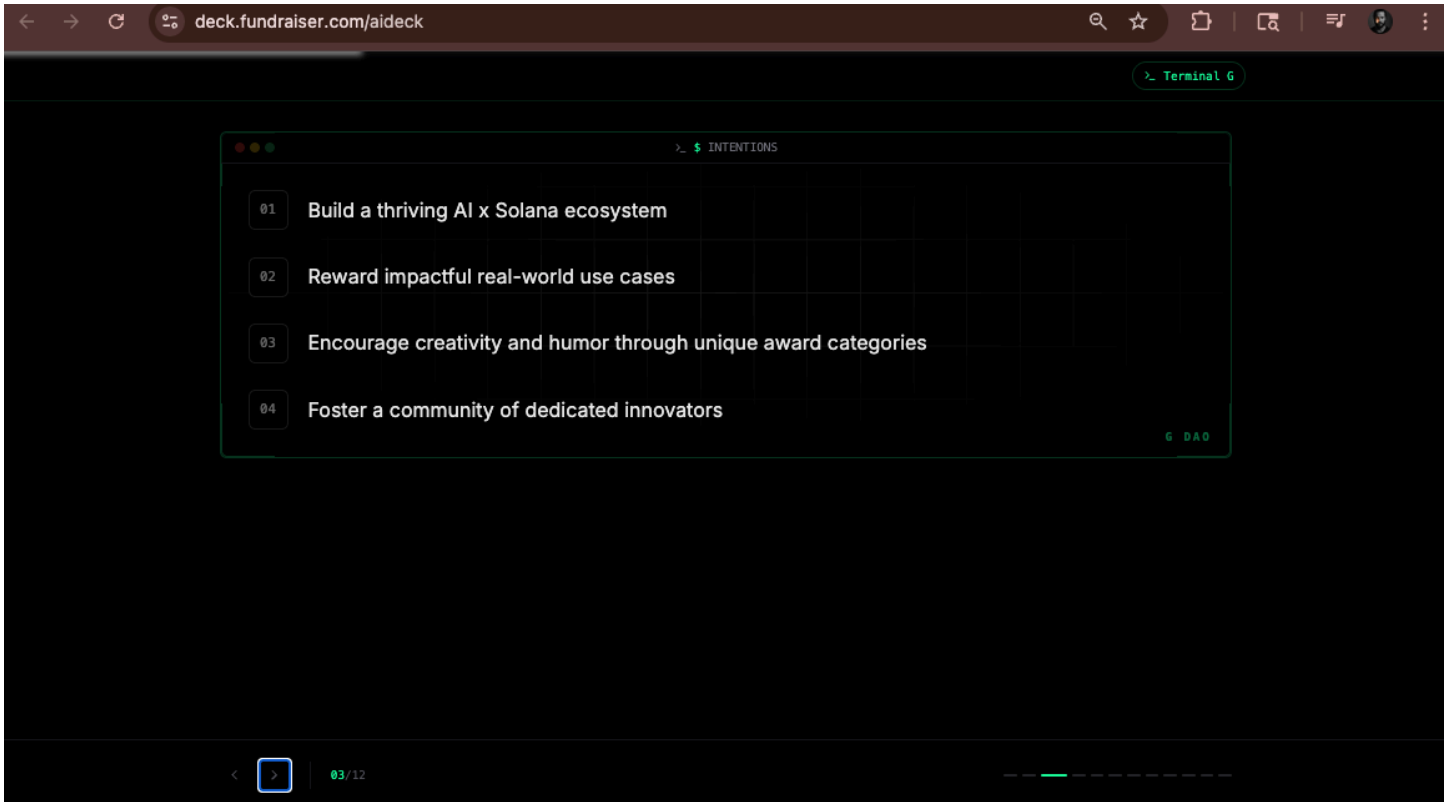

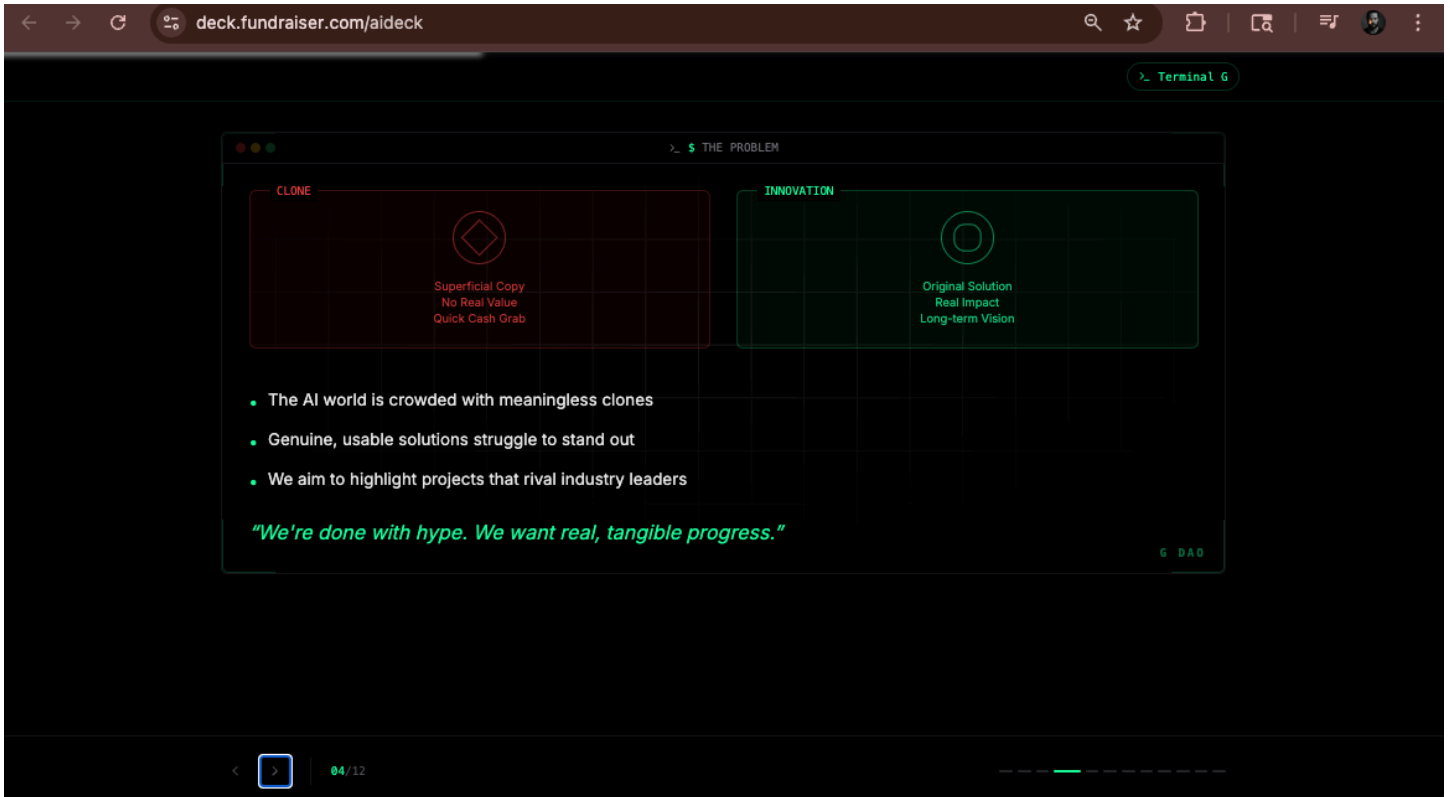

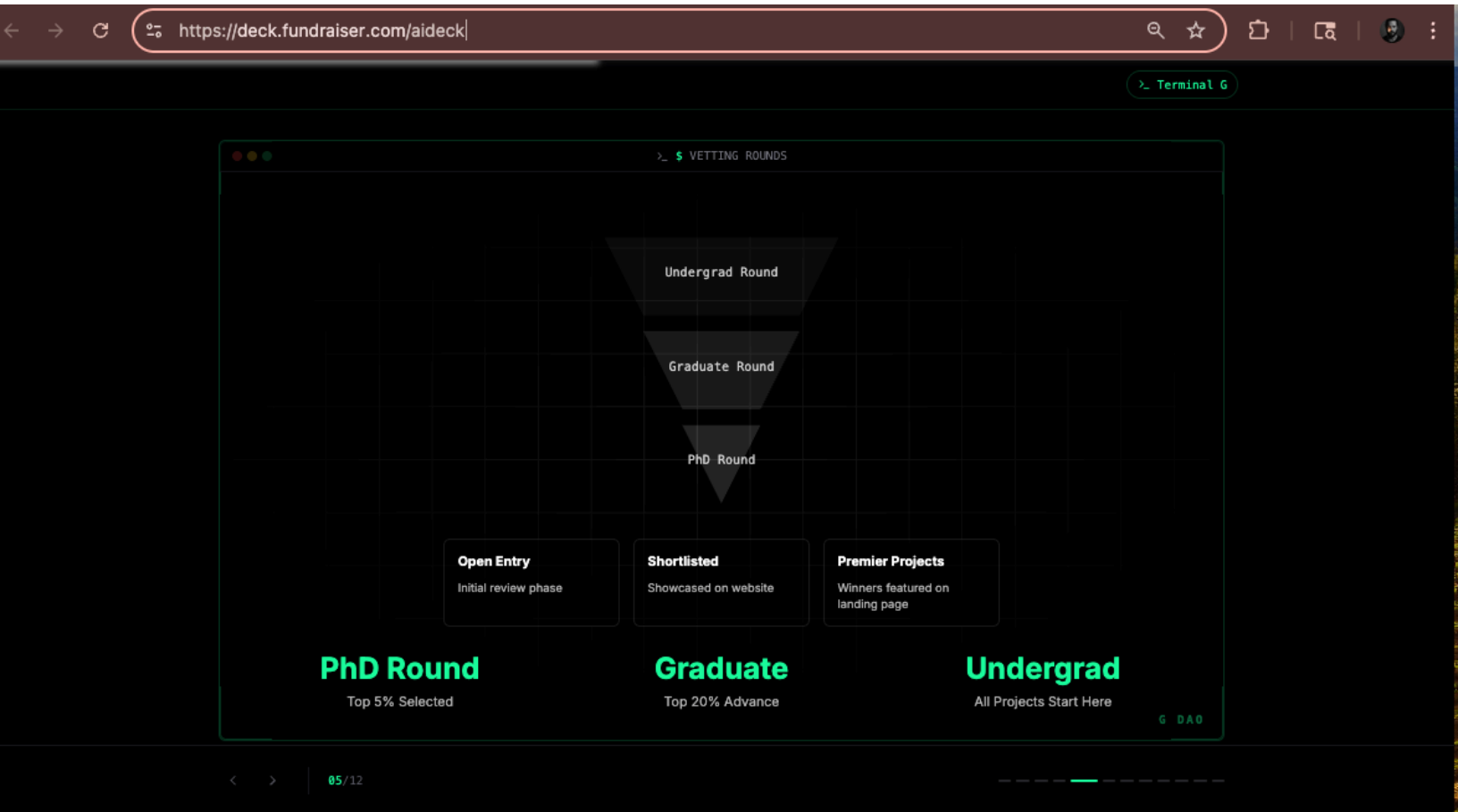

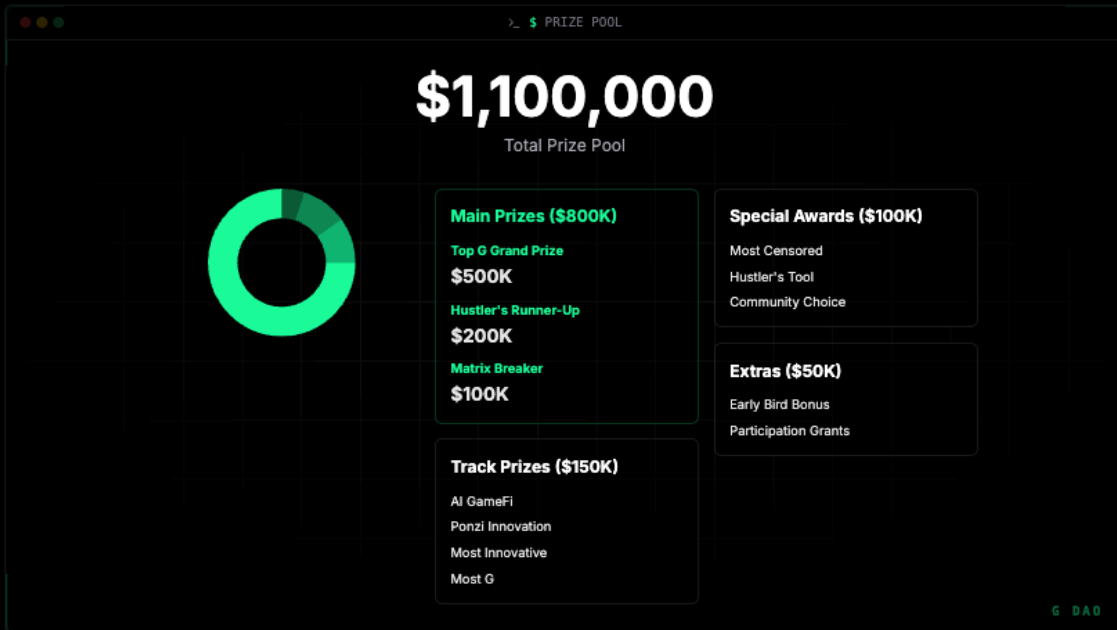

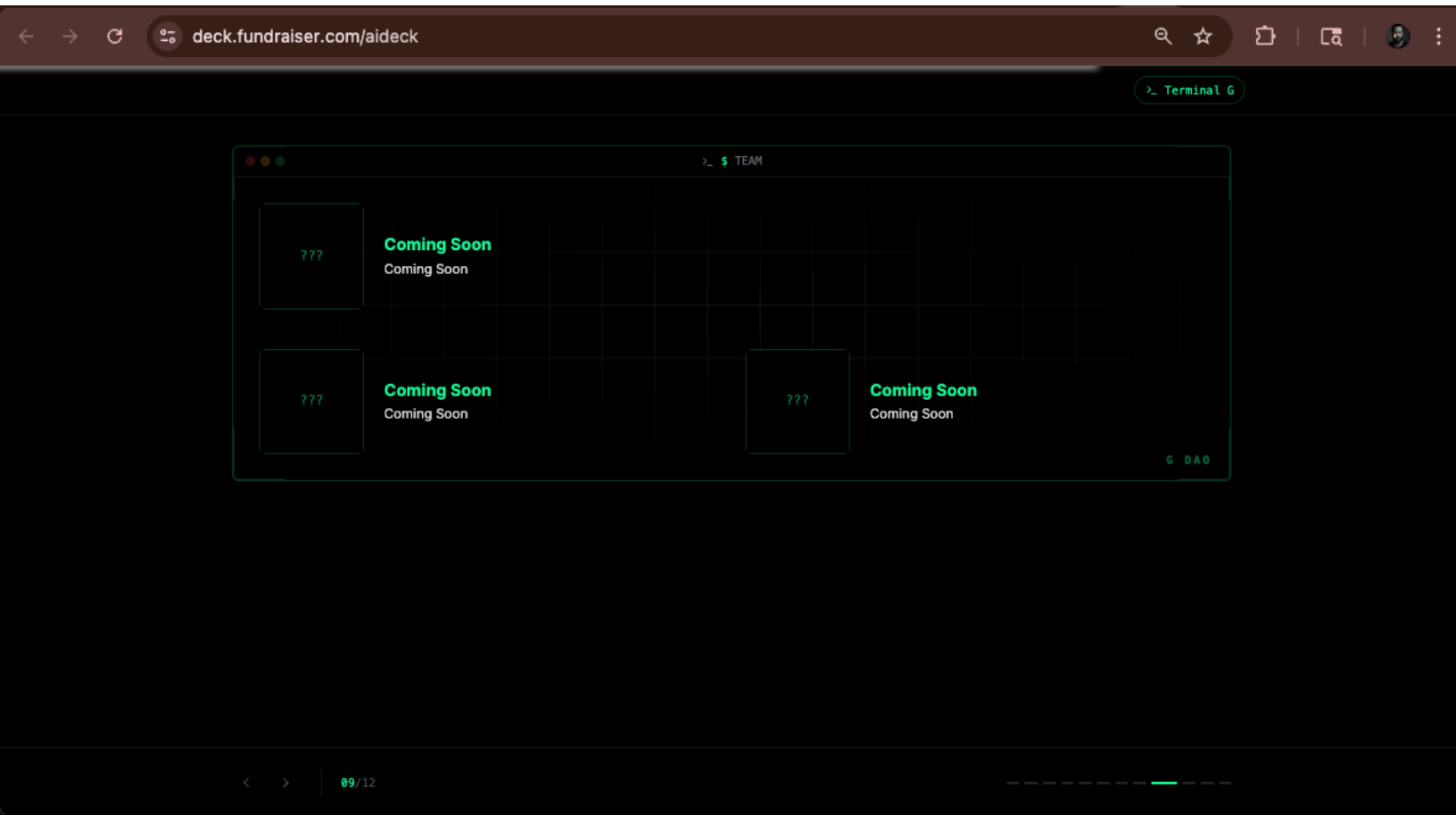

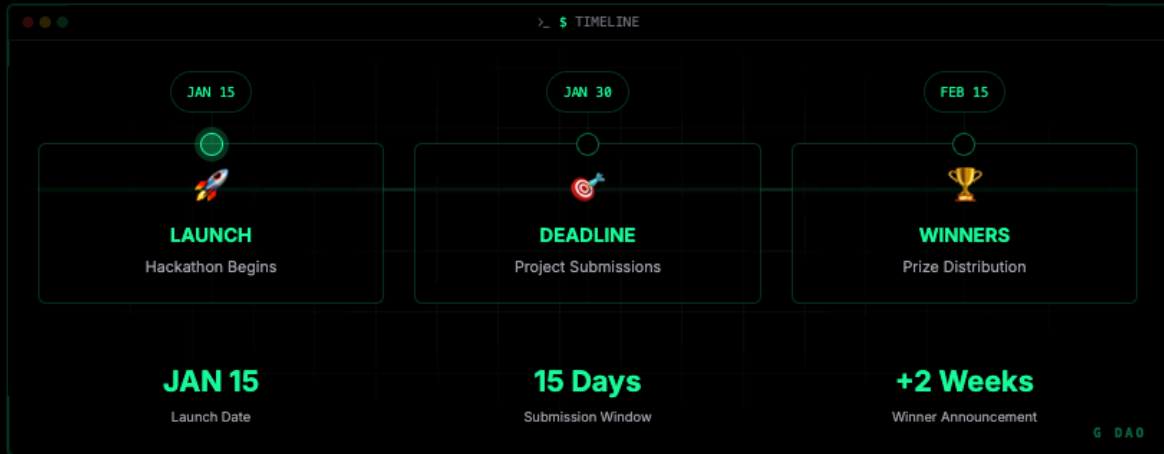

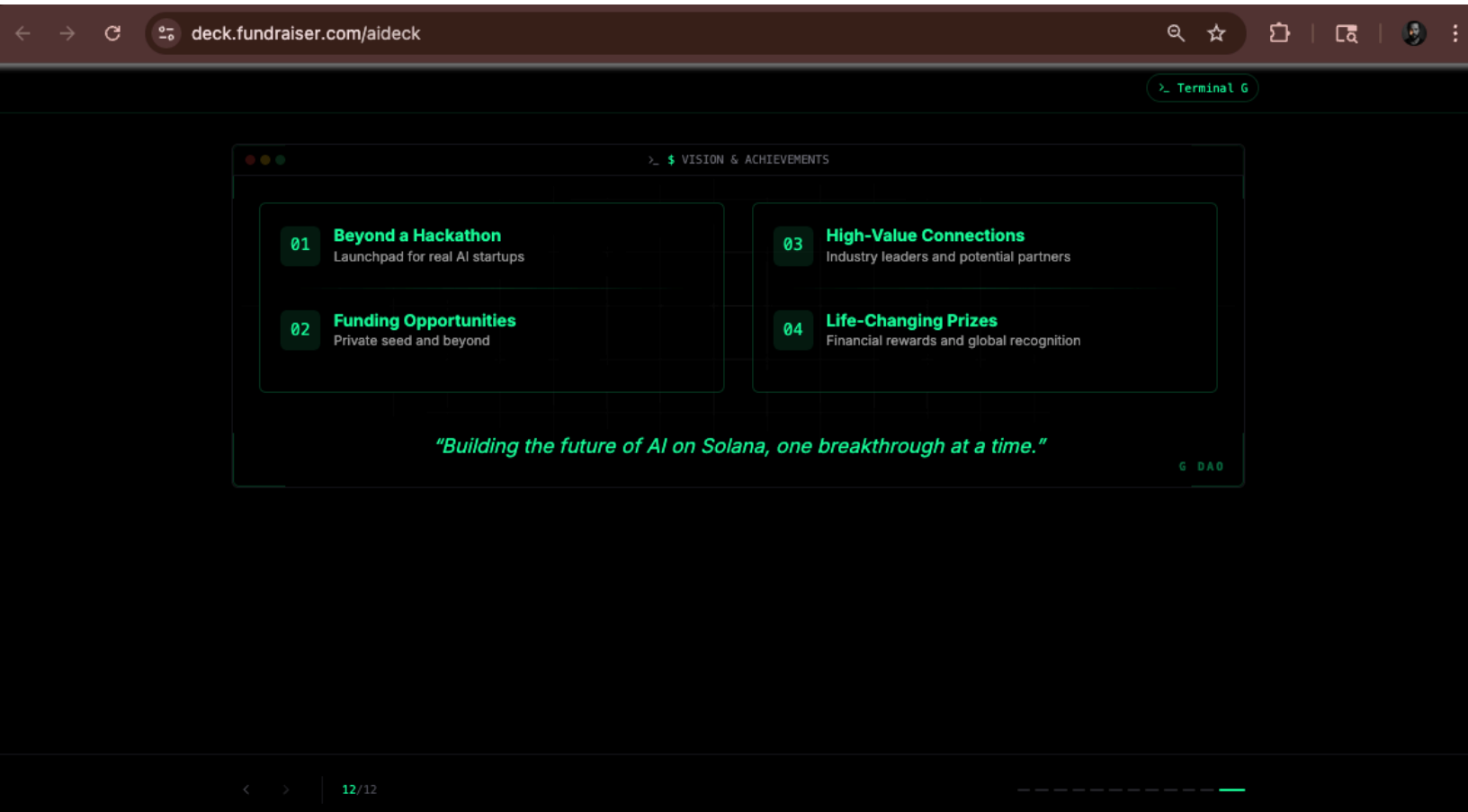

**DECLARATION OF BRYAN MITCHELL
IN SUPPORT OF PLAINTIFF'S FIRST AMENDED COMPLAINT**

I, Bryan Mitchell, declare as follows:

1. I am the brother of Plaintiff Anthony Mitchell. I am a resident of the State of Nevada. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth in this declaration and, if called as a witness, could and would competently testify to them.
2. I use the X/Twitter handle @prince_of_fakes (also known as Bry.ai). On January 30, 2025, I received a direct message on X/Twitter from the verified account @CobraTate, associated with Defendant Andrew Tate. Tate's message stated, in sequence: "Hey bro," "Head of hackathon wants to reach out," and "whats your telegram." I provided Tate with my Telegram contact information. Tate immediately replied: "sent you a msg ;)." Tate's message was not a general invitation to the Hackathon; it was a targeted, personalized outreach in which Tate identified my brother's project, contacted me by name, and obtained my Telegram so that the enterprise's hackathon administrator could reach me directly.
3. Within minutes of Tate's X/Twitter direct message, I was contacted on Telegram by an individual who identified himself as "Issa" (X/Twitter: @issathecooker). Issa's first messages were: "gm," "i'm issa," and "andrew told me to text you." Issa confirmed that my brother Anthony's project would be added to the fundraiser.com/hackathon product showcase. Issa then directed me to lock up remaining tokens, host a Twitter Space on short notice to discuss the project, and stated he would arrange for Tate to join. Issa identified himself as the developer of the \$DADDY token and stated he had "handled a

lot of very successful CTOs.” The timing — Tate’s DM, my providing my Telegram, Tate’s confirmation, and Issa’s near-instantaneous follow-up stating “andrew told me to text you” — left no doubt that Tate had personally arranged for Issa to contact me.

4. On January 31, 2025, at my brother Anthony's request and with his authorization, I posted the Bangchain AI project to the fundraiser.com Hackathon showcase page on my X/Twitter account (@prince_of_fakes). The post featured the Bangchain AI project developed by Anthony Mitchell as part of his Hackathon submission.
5. Later that same day — January 31, 2025 — Defendant Andrew Tate, using his @CobRatate account, publicly replied to my post. His reply stated: “This product is perfect for the average crypto trader tbh.” As of the date of this declaration, that reply has received approximately 71,500 views. A true and correct screen capture of that reply is attached hereto as Exhibit 28 to Plaintiff’s First Amended Complaint.
6. Tate's public reply characterizing Anthony's AI hackathon submission as “perfect for the average crypto trader” was not accurate. Bangchain was an AI project, not a cryptocurrency trading product. I did not authorize Defendant Tate or any other Defendant to describe Anthony's AI project as a cryptocurrency product, and no such characterization was warranted by the nature of the submission.
7. I received no further communication from Defendant Tate, from “Issa,” or from any agent or representative of the Hackathon organizers regarding judging, prize disbursement, or the outcome of Anthony's submission after January 31, 2025.
8. The direct message I received from @CobRatate on January 30, 2025, as well as the follow-up message from “Issa,” were consistent with Defendant Tate's public promotion of the Hackathon and his stated personal commitment to sponsor it. Those communications led me to believe — and to encourage my brother Anthony to believe — that the Hackathon was a legitimate competition with genuine prize commitments, and that Defendant Tate was personally involved in its administration.
9. I declare under penalty of perjury pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746 that the foregoing is true and correct.

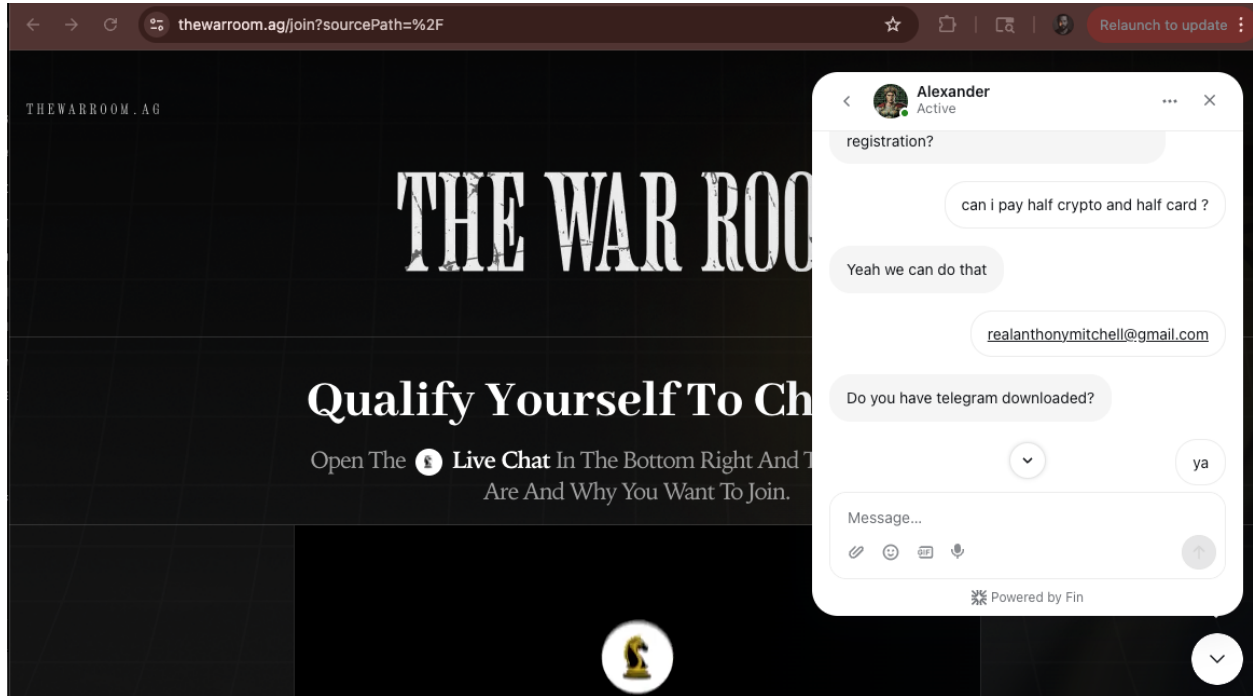

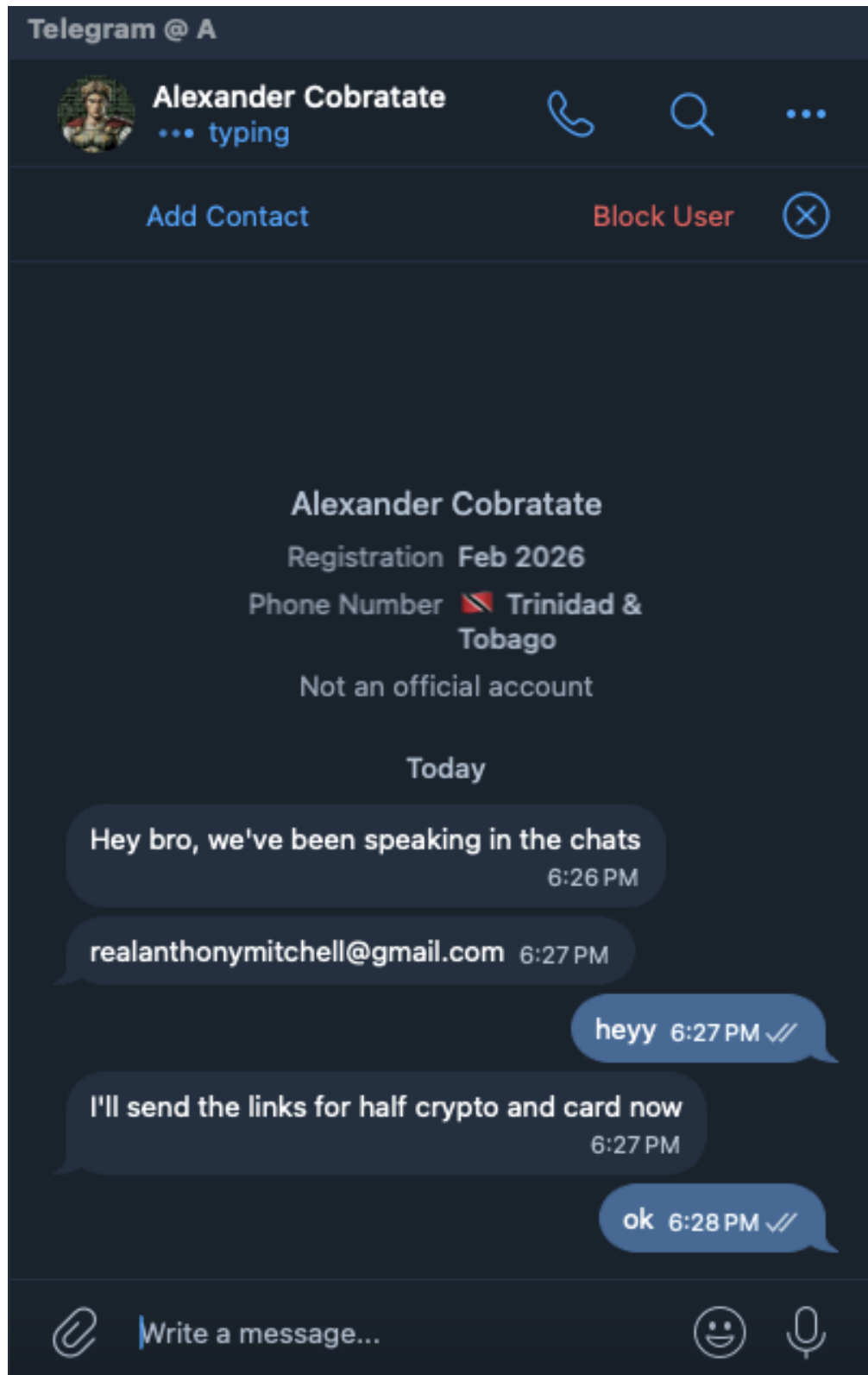

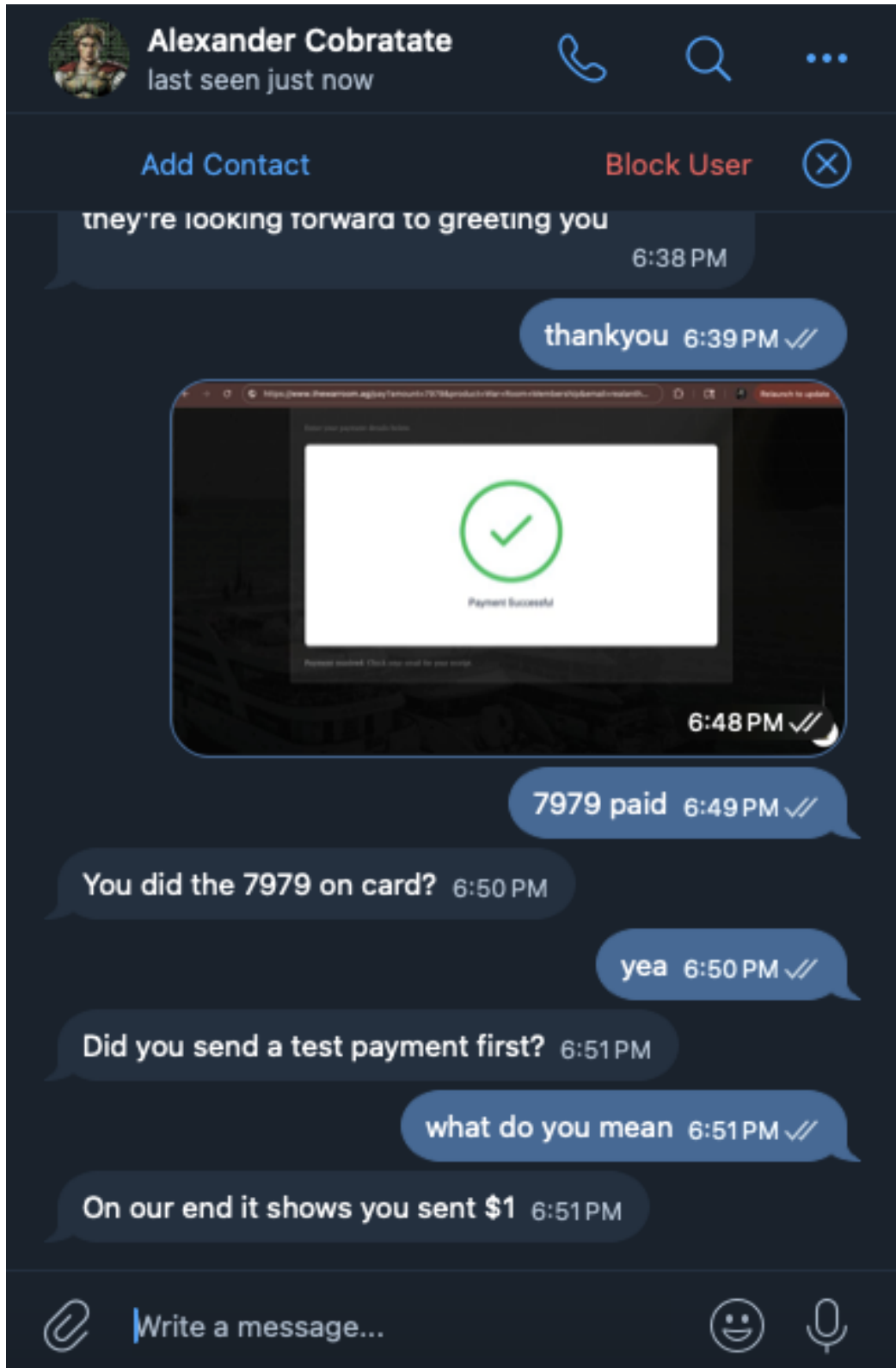

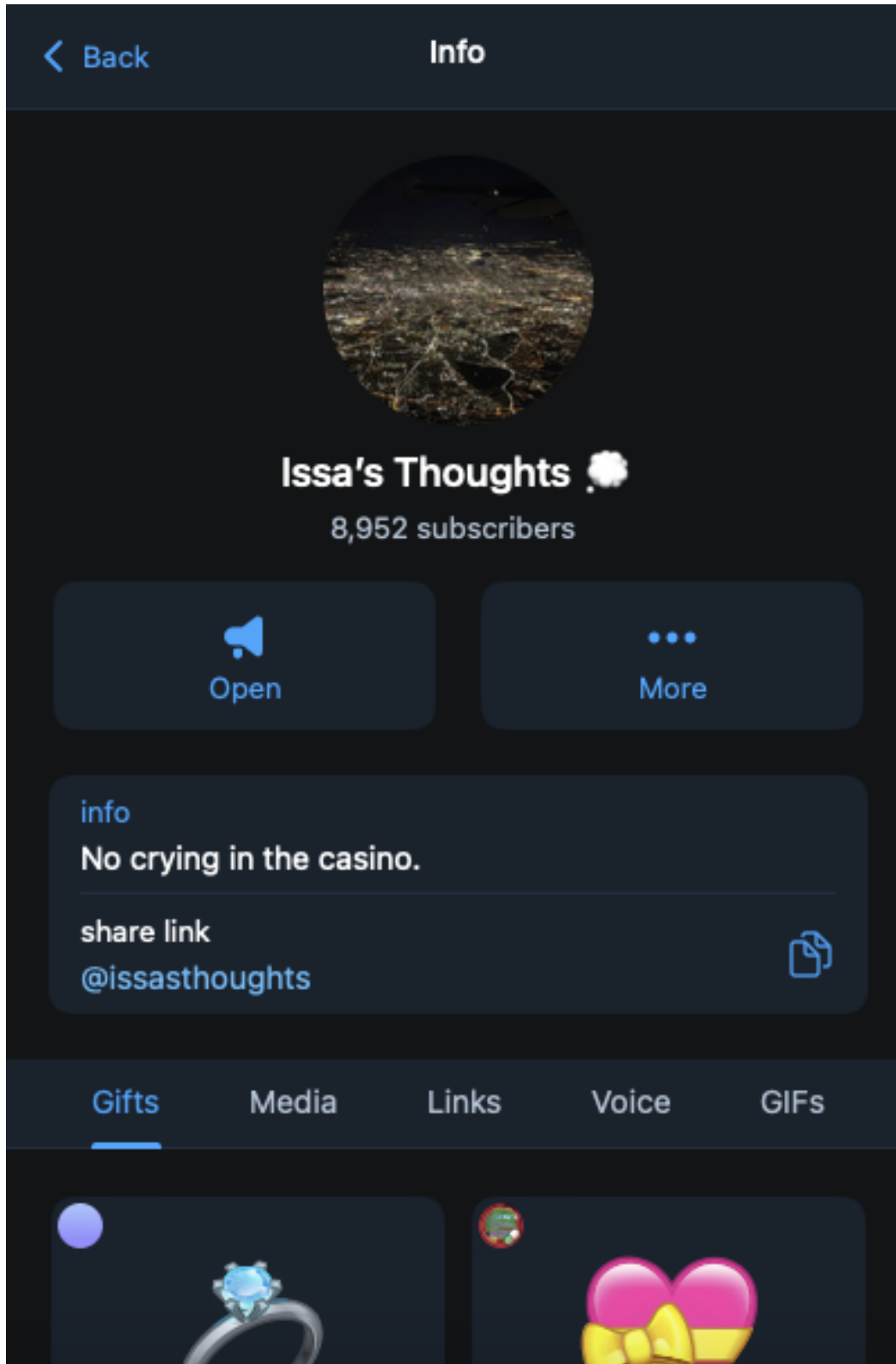
