**[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING
PLAINTIFF’S MOTION FOR
ALTERNATIVE SERVICE PURSUANT
TO FRCP 4(f)(3)**

THIS MATTER having come before the Court upon Plaintiff Anthony Mitchell’s Motion for Order Authorizing Alternative Service of Process on Defendant Emory Andrew Tate III Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(f)(3) (the “Motion”); the Court having considered the Motion and the Declaration of Anthony Mitchell with exhibits, including the Affidavit of Due Diligence of Rachelle Dabrowski, Verite Investigations LLC, dated March 7, 2026; the Court having found that Plaintiff has demonstrated diligent, good-faith efforts to effect conventional service; the Court having found that the proposed methods are not prohibited by any applicable international agreement, including the Hague Convention on the Service Abroad of Judicial and Extrajudicial Documents; the Court having found that the proposed methods are reasonably calculated to apprise Defendant Tate of the pendency of this action under *Mullane v. Central Hanover Bank & Trust Co.*, 339 U.S. 306, 314 (1950); and good cause appearing therefor:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff’s Motion is **GRANTED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff is authorized to effect service of process on Defendant Emory Andrew Tate III by serving the summons, complaint, and all related service

2 Floor, Miami, Florida 33126, via email to tamaniotis@equitylegal.net and via overnight
3 courier to the foregoing address.

5 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Plaintiff is authorized to effect service of process on
6 Defendant Emory Andrew Tate III by serving the summons, complaint, and all related service
7 documents on **Raymond E. Brenneman, Esq.**, Brenneman APC, 1901 Avenue of the Stars,
8 Suite 200, Los Angeles, California 90067, via email to raymond@brennemanlegal.com and
9 via overnight courier to the foregoing address.

11 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that any counsel served pursuant to the two immediately
12 preceding paragraphs shall forward a complete copy of the summons, complaint, and all
13 related service documents to Defendant Emory Andrew Tate III within **seven (7) days** of
14 receipt and shall file a notice of forwarding with this Court confirming such transmittal within
15 two (2) days thereafter.

17 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Plaintiff is authorized to effect service of process on
18 Defendant Emory Andrew Tate III by transmitting the summons, complaint, and all related
19 service documents via direct message to the @Cobratate account on X (Twitter)
20 (@Cobratate), with contemporaneous screenshot documentation preserved as proof of
21 service.

23 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Plaintiff is authorized to effect service of process on
24 Defendant Emory Andrew Tate III by transmitting the summons, complaint, and all related
25 service documents via the contact form infrastructure on therealworld.org and
26 fundraiser.com, with contemporaneous screenshot documentation preserved as proof of
27 service.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff may transmit a supplementary copy of the summons and complaint via FedEx international air mail, with tracking, to Strada Drumul Bisericii 50A, 077190 Voluntari, Romania; provided that this transmittal shall not constitute primary service of process and service shall be deemed complete upon accomplishment of one or more of the methods described in paragraphs 2 through 5 above.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that completion of service by any one or more of the primary methods in paragraphs 2 through 5 above, as documented by Plaintiff in a proof of service filed with this Court, shall constitute effective service of process on Defendant Emory Andrew Tate III under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(f)(3).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff shall complete alternative service within **45 days** of the date of this Order and shall file proof of service with the Court within 7 days of completing service.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant Emory Andrew Tate III shall file an answer or otherwise respond to the complaint within **60 days** of the date on which service is completed.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
