Dear Mr. Sherman:

I am writing to you as counsel of record for Defendant Thrifty Consulting LLC in case 2:26-cv-00720 .

I understand that you are also in communication with Defendants Andrew Joslin and Thrift Technologies LLC in connection with this litigation, and that you may become counsel of record for those defendants upon formal service and appearance. On May 21, 2026, the Clerk of Court issued summonses for Andrew Joslin and Thrift Technologies LLC (ECF No. 39). Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(d), I am forwarding the enclosed waiver of service materials and respectfully request that you either execute the enclosed waiver forms on behalf of those defendants if you are authorized to do so, or transmit these materials to them directly.

Please return the executed waiver forms for each client by June 20, 2026 (30 days from the date of this request, pursuant to FRCP 4(d)(1)(F)). If your clients execute and return the waivers, they will have until July 20, 2026 (60 days from today) to file a response to the First Amended Complaint, rather than the standard 21-day period that would follow formal service. This additional time should facilitate an efficient and orderly briefing schedule on your clients' pending Rule 12(b)(6) motion.

If your clients decline to execute and return the waivers within the stated period, I will arrange for formal service on Andrew Joslin through a process server and on Thrift Technologies LLC through its registered agent (Cogency Global Inc., 850 New Burton Road, Suite 201, Dover, DE 19904), and I will request that the Court assess the costs of service against your clients pursuant to FRCP 4(d)(2).

Additionally, should Andrew Joslin and Thrift Technologies LLC execute and return the enclosed waivers, I would also be amenable to a reasonable extension of Thrifty Consulting LLC's deadline to answer the First Amended Complaint, to be coordinated by stipulation consistent with the Court's scheduling requirements.
